In July 2015, the global NCD Alliance led by 7 international NGO federations and WHO South-East Asia Regional Office convened a Consultation of Civil Society Organisations from the Region to deliberate on the role that CSOs can play to achieve the 10 national targets adopted by India under the National Action Plan to reduce premature NCD mortality by 25% by 2025.
